Stimulating environments for professional development and innovation in schools




CLIMATE is the acronym for Contextual Learning in Management and Teaching. It is a Comenius multilateral project under the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Commission.

For Whom?

If you are a teacher trainer, a school manager, head of department or teacher / school advisor, CLIMATE can provide you with the concepts, instruments and strategies to make schools and work units within schools more effective and productive learning environments for teachers.

The Idea


Starting point is the idea that school is a place for learning not only for students but also for teachers. Schools and work units within a school of school are considered learning organizations, which have implicit or explicit corporate curricula. The corporate curriculum can enhance learning processes or hinder them.



The Instrument

The main instrument of the project is a validated questionnaire, which can be applied by work units in schools, for example teachers of one subject, of one class or of a certain level. This questionnaire is an instrument for teachers to analyze their own work environment in order to explore if and to what extent it is a learning environment to them.

A detailed feedback report given to the work units stimulates the development of action plans for further improvement.
